- Get a competitive edge with part-time and volunteering work experience.







Did you know?


If you graduate from Aston within the last three years, you can still use Aston Futures. You will just need to create a graduate account using your personal email address.

Setting up and maintaining your profile

Setting up your profile is simple. You'll need to answer a few questions about yourself, including your preferences, then you're good to go. The world is your oyster.

Our tips...

- Choose what kind of opportunities you're interested in. Fancy an English-speaking placement abroad? No problem, tick the box. Got your sights set on summer internships in the UK? You've got it, tick the box.
- Select occupational areas. If you've got your heart set on project management roles, select your preference, and we'll send you roles about project management. Easy peasy.
- Make sure you update your profile preferences throughout your time at Aston. Things change, and we'd hate for you to get emails about things you couldn't give two hoots about.




Did you know?

Once you're logged in, you'll see your dashboard. This has all kinds of super helpful and interesting information.

Notices

Check these for any important messages. The C+P team will use this to send you messages about things you might be interested in, so do take a look.

Appointments

When you make appointments on Aston Futures (we'll get to that shortly, don't you worry), you get a handy little reminder of them on your dashboard.

Queries

If you've asked us questions about events or roles, you'll be able to view them on your dashboard and see if we've answered them yet.

Events

A great little space to see all the events you've booked onto. You know, in case you forget.

Opportunities

A list of opportunities you might be interested in. You're welcome.


Organisations

Searching for marvellous opportunities

We've got more opportunities on Aston Futures than you can shake a stick at. Summer internships, part-time jobs, volunteering roles, placements, graduate jobs – we've got everything you could ever want (except fluffy kittens, we don't provide those sadly).



Tip 1

There's a filter on the left-hand side of the screen. Use this to narrow down your search.

Choose your...

Opportunity Type

Examples include: Volunteering with a national charity in the UK, Placements UK, Graduate Employment Abroad.

Business Area

Examples include: Banking, Engineering, Healthcare, Marketing and Supply Chain Management.

Location

Examples include: Birmingham, Scotland, London, Wales, Northern Ireland.

Size of company


Choose whether you'd like to work in an SME or not (FYI – SME = small or medium-sized enterprise).


More tips for opportunity searching

Tip 2 Use the Quick Search

The quick search allows you to search using key words, a reference ID, or an organisation.

For example, if you desperately want some experience with BMW Group, you can type their name in the Organisation Search, hit enter, and you'll see all the live vacancies they have. Pretty handy, right?





Opportunity Fact File

Once you've found an opportunity you're interested in, take a look at the Fact File section.

Part-Time Pharmacy Assistant

We are currently looking for a Pharmacy Student to work at our Solihull branch. You must be studying for your MPharm

Degree and provide a university document confirming; University Name, Your Name and Course Title.

- Your overall responsibility will be to participate in the whole dispensing process. The role will also involve establishing and
 developing long term relationships with customers ensuring to always deliver courteous and effective customer service.
- You will be required to assist in the delivery of all commercial pharmacy services where appropriate. In this role you will be required to complete administrative records, and ensure that these records are adequately maintained.
- You will effectively manage pharmaceutical stock which includes receiving, storing and maintaining adequate stock levels. This will be required for the stock in the shop aswell as the dispensary.
- You may be required to deliver healthcare advice and signpost where necessary.

- Check salary, location, and occupational areas.




Making the most of appointment bookings

If you'd like to chat with one of our fab Careers Consultants, Placement Coordinators or JobShop, you can book

appointments with them on Aston Futures.

- There are different types of appointments you can book, depending on your year and what type of advice you need.
- You can select the kind of appointment you need and view available slots.
- Virtual, telephone or face-to-face (when the Centre re-opens) appointments can be booked, which means we can be flexible around your needs.
- Indicate the kind of support you need whether it's CV feedback, exploring your options, or psychometric testing.
- You can also add additional notes to your appointment booking and you can upload documents (sending us your CV in advance would be super helpful, thanks).

P.S. You'll get an email confirmation of your appointment, and you'll be able to see it on the dashboard, so you won't forget!






Did you know?

- You can also ask us questions about events!




Here's an example of an event you can book
